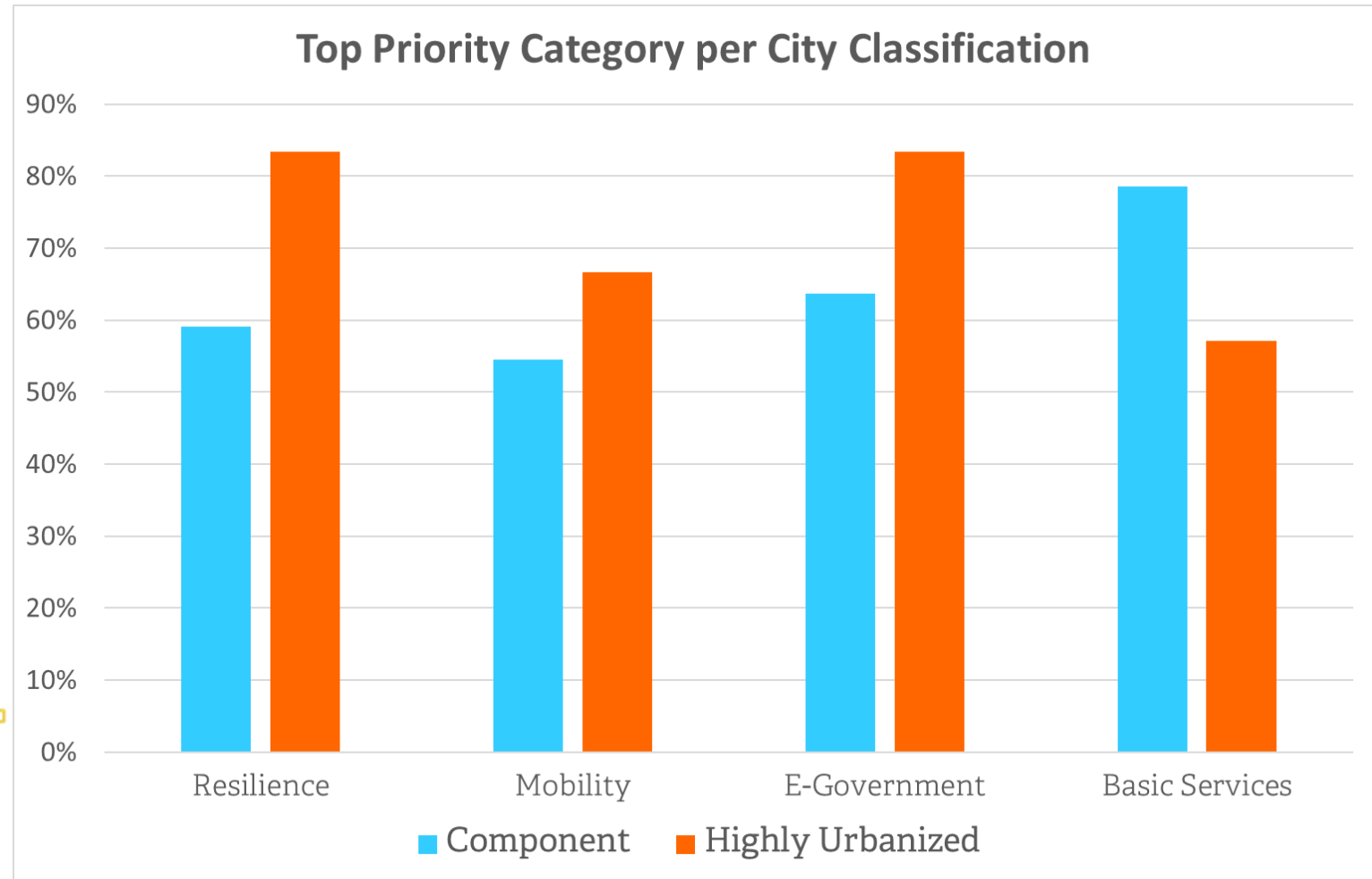

# Mayors' Survey Results

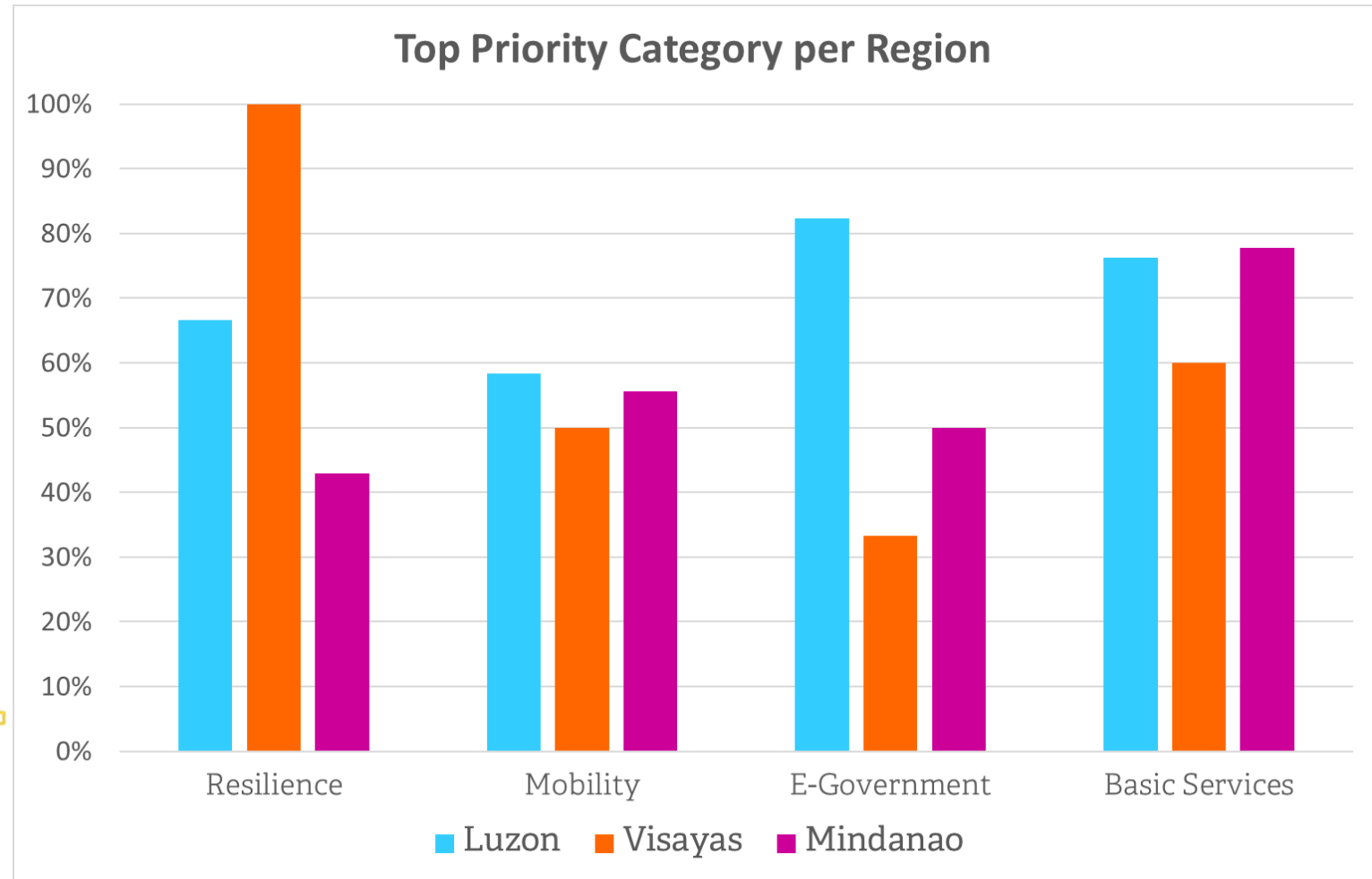
Crowne Plaza Ortigas
