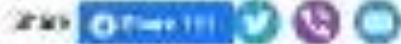




## Bacolod City, DOH open 1st hospital-based Level 3 biolab in PH

**COVID-19 TEST LAB.** The opening of the building and the opening of the Center for Molecular Microbiology (CLMMRH) Bacolod City Molecular Laboratory was held in front of the laboratory building on Tuesday, July 11, 2020, with the presence of DOH and CLMMRH officials. The laboratory was inaugurated by DOH and CLMMRH officials. The laboratory is located at the CLMMRH building, Bacolod City. The laboratory is a Level 3 (BSL3) Molecular Laboratory. The laboratory is the first of its kind in the Philippines. The laboratory was inaugurated on July 11, 2020.

# ● DOH 1<sup>ST</sup> HOSPITAL-BASED BIOLAB



The City of Bacolod has partnered with the Department of Health (DOH) in establishing the first hospital-based Level 3 testing laboratory in the country to strengthen its response to the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) pandemic. It is officially named the CLMMRH-Bacolod City Bio-Safety Level 3 (BSL3) Molecular Laboratory.



# ● SWAB MOBILE



The **Swab Mobile** is aimed at ensuring the protection of medical front-liners as they do swab tests and at the same time to avoid unnecessary movements of patients as we will test them wherever they are," Bacolod Mayor Evelio Leonardia said.

The Bacolod Filipino-Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BFCCCI) and BioPower group donated the 2 swab mobiles.

The **Bacolod City COVID-19 Contact Tracing System BaCTrac**) was enacted through City Ordinance No. 941 on September 23, 2020.

A localized web and mobile application that uses a QR Code to contain and avert the spread or transmission of the virus through the quick and immediate contact tracing of people who may have been exposed to positive COVID-19 patients.



The system, developed by the provincial government of South Cotabato, led by **Gov. Reynaldo S. Tamayo, Jr.**, was cited by the UN General Assembly, during the Open Government Partnership (OGP) Leaders' Summit last Sept. 25.

It was showcased as a great example of cross-sector collaboration in the fight against COVID-19. The OGP described the SC-CCTS as a great effort that discloses accurate contact tracing information designed to include marginalized communities and disadvantaged sectors - those without mobile phones and without access to the internet or Bluetooth.

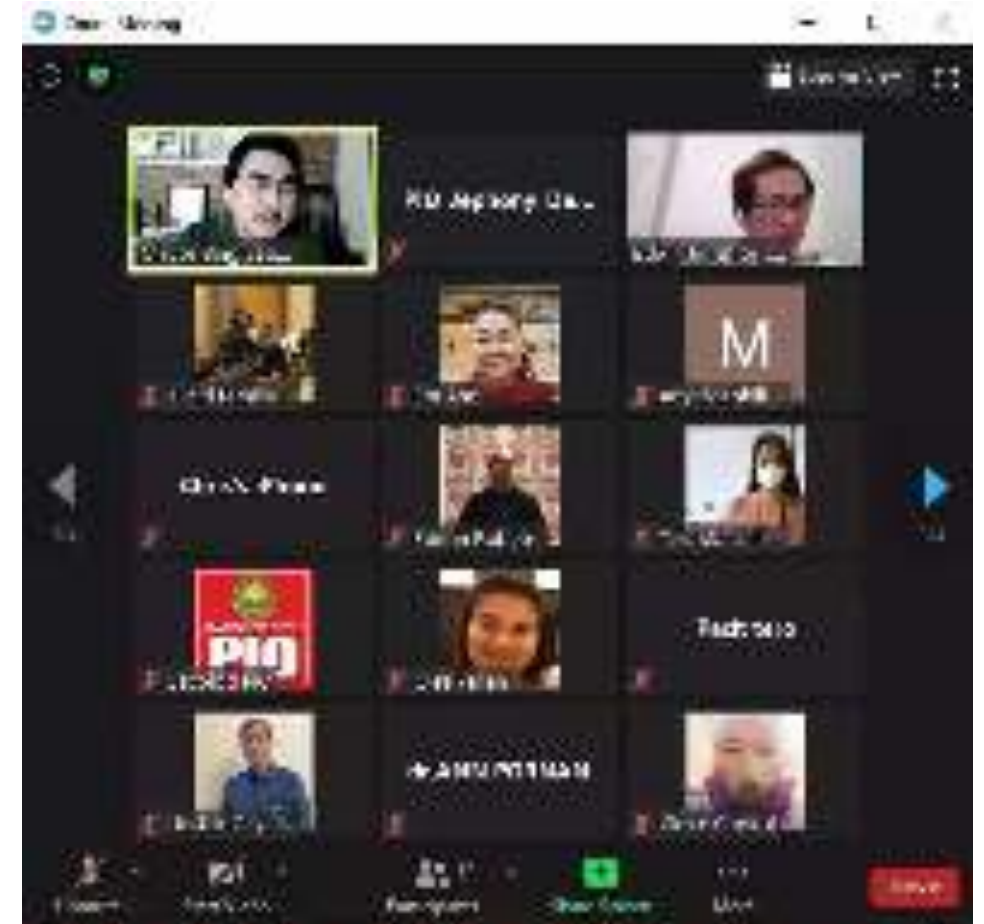
