

### BHP Philippines: Global health partnerships as enabler of costeffective and sustainable UHC


- The NHS Consortium convened series of virtual knowledge exchanges between NICE and the Department of Health, Philippines (DOH) on health technology assessment (HTA).
- In Nov 2020, DOH published its first national HTA guidelines under the UHC Law, drawing on NICE advice and tools, which will help ensure that medicines provided under UHC are good value for money.
- At LGU level, complementary technical/academic input from BHP Delivery Partner on design and implementation of local HTA training courses and clinical pathways.
- Institutional partnerships continue at national level (DOH-NICE) and at LGU level (Pasig City-University of Glasgow, through BHP Delivery Partner)
