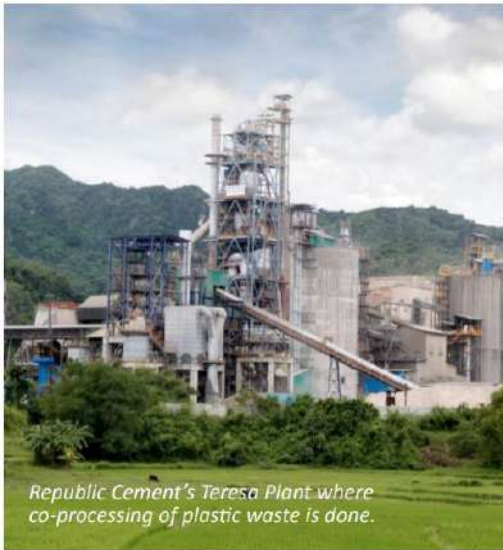

Use of rice husks to cut more than 60% of bunker fuel use.

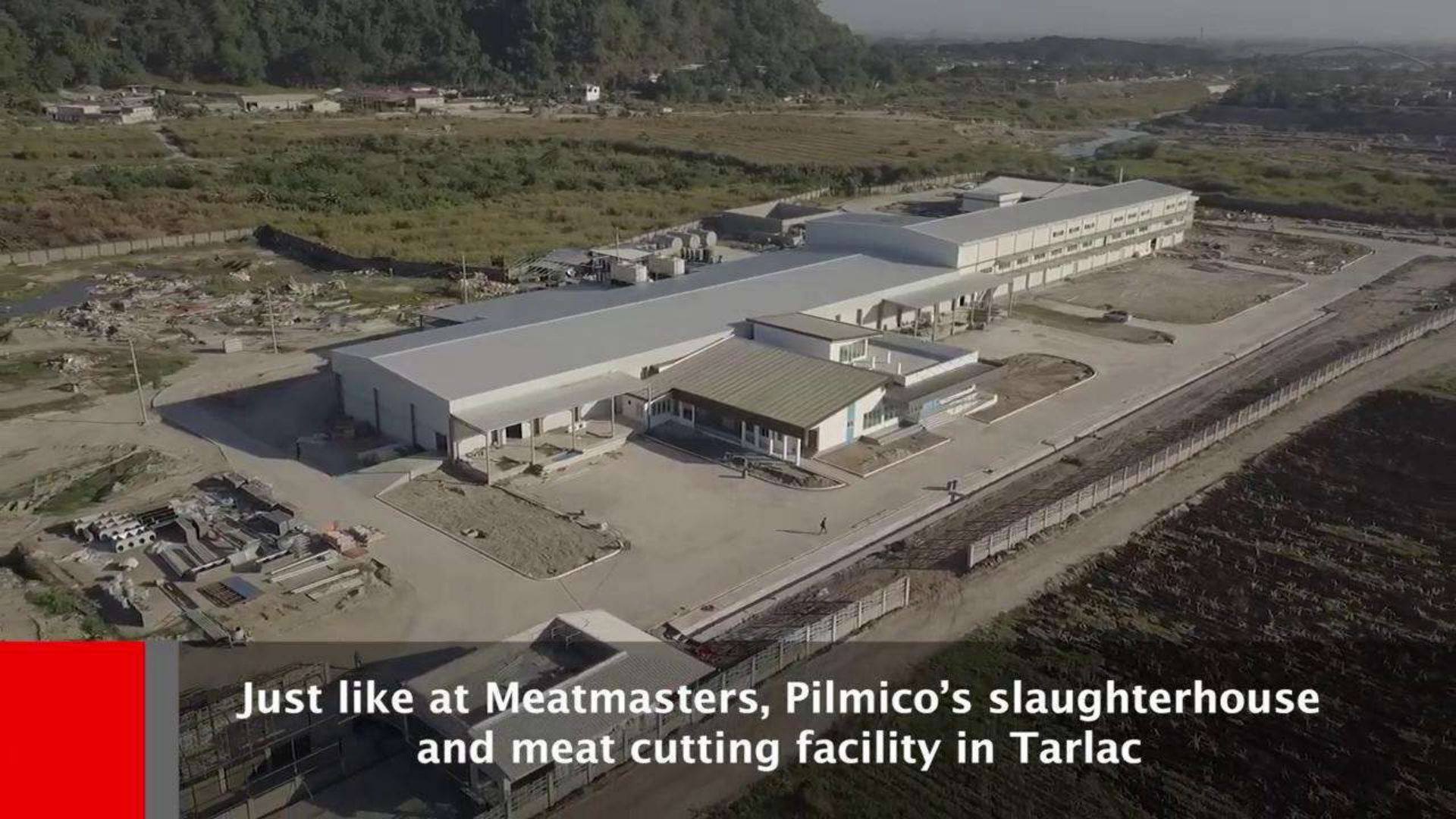


Use of waste ash from burned rice husks as an alternative mix to cement
