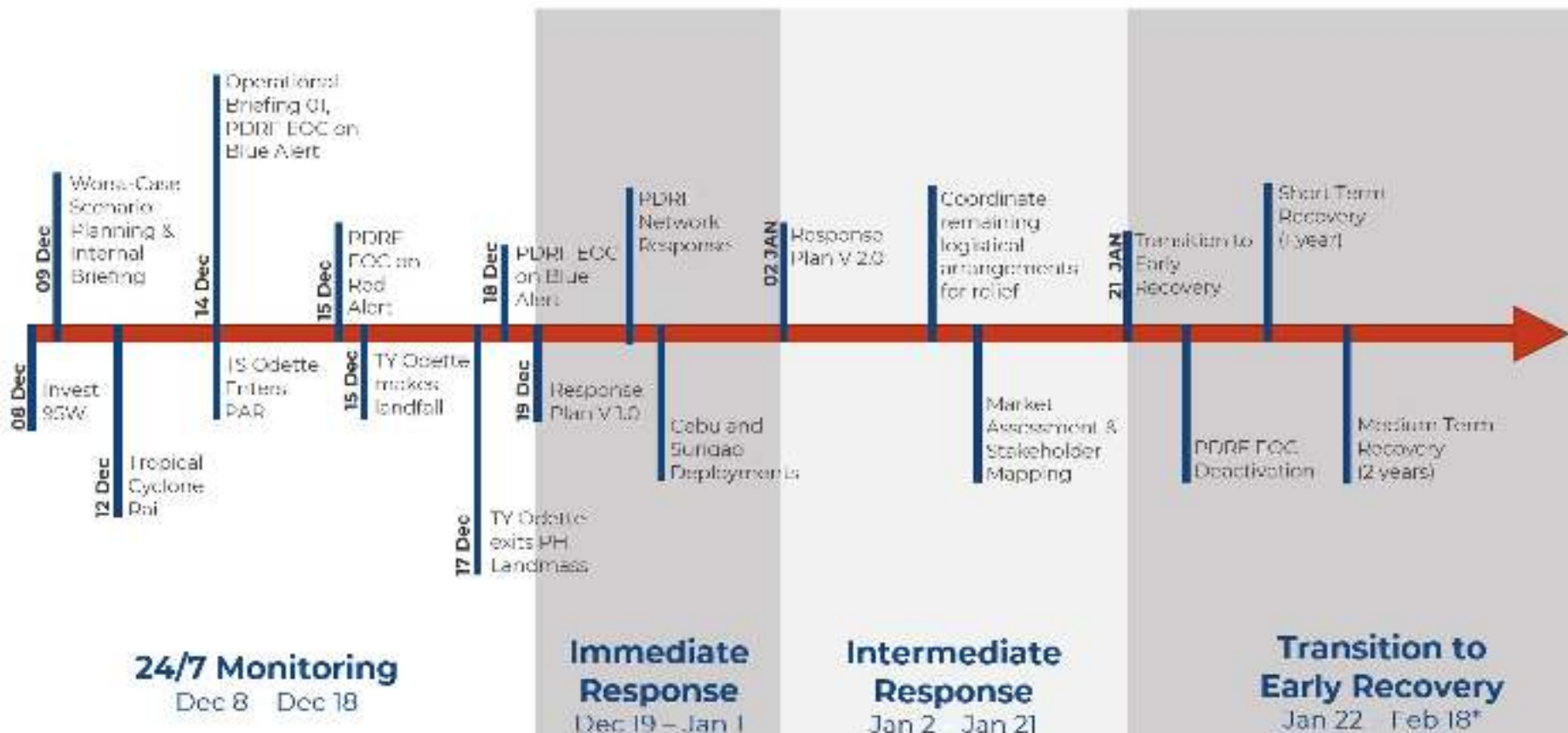

Affected Persons	16.1 Million	8.34 Million
Damaged Houses	1.14 Million	1.37 Million
Total Amount of Damages	Php 95.5 Billion	Php 33.3 Billion
Power	25 Days 100% Restored	33 Days 97% Restored
Water	Limited water supply 5 months after Yolanda	27 Municipalities Affected 26% Restored
Telecom	419 Municipalities 71% Restored 10 days after	247 Municipalities Affected 73% Restored

PRIVATE SECTOR SUPPORT

- Logistics support - cargo space and passenger seats (air and sea), trucking
- Emergency Power - generator sets, fuel provision
- Emergency Telco support - comms equipment (satphones), technical support
- Food and Non-Food relief allocation and distributions
- Search and Rescue coordination
