



VISION 2028

One of the three best urbanized cities in the country in terms of livability, competitiveness, viability and governance practice by 2028

BREAKTHROUGH

- 15% increase in citizen satisfaction rating (2005-2009)
- Reduction of business permits processing from one month to one day





Balanga, Bataan

The emerging hub for knowledge-based businesses

BREAKTHROUGH (2007-2015)

- 112% increase in Registered Businesses
- 429% increase in Gross Sales
- Internal Revenue Allotment from 73% to 58%







San Fernando, Pampanga

VISION 2022

City of San Fernando Pampanga: Center of Kapampangan Culture, a preferred tourism destination in Asia by 2022

BREAKTHROUGH (2010-2013)

- 57% Increase in visitor arrivals during cultural events
- 13% increase in Mean Percentage Score in NAT(Primary Schools)
- 19% increase in Mean Percentage Score in NAT(Secondary Schools)
- 17% increase in Total income-GF (Local Income)
- Reduction of poverty incidence from 33% to 9%.

BREAKTHROUGH

VISION 2020

BREAKTHROUGH

- 30% increase in registered businesses
- 32% increase in local income generated
- DOT-recognition as one of the top MICE destinations in the Philippines



Final Words
